An Important Note on School Communication

We take communication to our parents very seriously. It has come to our attention that some of the important messages are either not being received or overlooked. Please take a few minutes to understand our communication procedures and ensure you are getting all of the information being sent to you. We are mindful in the messages we send and are cautious about not sending messages we don't feel are pertinent.

EMAILS & NEWSLETTERS: The newsletters are sent weekly and often contain upcoming dates, school news, and student responsibilities for the week.

Please make sure schoolmail@gradelink.com is added to your safe senders list.

REMIND APP: This is where Roncy sends out messages that require your **immediate attention**. We also use it for shorter communications, announcements and general reminders. It's a great tool that lets us very quickly send messages to the entire school as well as individual classes. Please do not ignore these messages.

Remind messages can come to you via email, text message or mobile app available on Android or IOS. You may update your communication preferences in the mobile app or by logging into Remind.com on any web browser.

If you're set up for text messages, the reminders will come not come from 505 phone numbers. The phone numbers are unique and randomly assigned by the Remind app to each class owner, such as Roncy and Jenn. Please save the numbers to your contacts to ensure you know where the message is coming from.

Don't be afraid to reply to these messages, in fact we encourage it. Give a thumbs up, a thumbs down, or type in a reply. It helps us know you're seeing the messages. Any replies you send are only seen by the person who sent the announcement, they do not go to the entire school or classes.

If you are not receiving BOTH emails and remind messages please let me know immediately.
